Included within the scope of this waiver and release is any cause of action (including any cause of action based on negligence) arising from the performance, or failure to perform, maintenance, inspection, supervision, or control of said areas and for the failure to warn of dangerous conditions existing during said activity.

Furthermore, we (I), on behalf of our minor Participant(s), hereby assume all risk of personal injury, sickness, death, damage, and expense as a result of participation in recreational activities involved.

Further, authorization and permission are given to the Church to furnish any necessary transportation, food, and lodging for the Participant(s). The undersigned further hereby agree to hold harmless and indemnify said Church for any liability sustained by said Church as the result of the negligent, willful, or intentional acts of said Participant(s), including expenses incurred attendant thereto.

**MEDICAL TREATMENT PERMISSION:** We (I), as parents/legal guardians of the minor Participant(s) give our permission for him/her to participate fully in the Event. We give our permission to take said participant to a doctor or hospital and authorize medical treatment, including but not in limitation to emergency surgery or medical treatment, and assume the responsibility of all medical bills, if any. We understand that we will be contacted if reasonably possible, but in the event that he/she cannot be reached, the Church may choose a reputable physician.

**TRANSPORTATION:** Should it be necessary for the Participant(s) to return home due to medical reasons, disciplinary action, or otherwise, the undersigned shall assume all transportation costs and responsibility. The undersigned does also hereby give permission for the Participant(s) to ride in any vehicle driven by an approved ADULT chaperone while attending and participating in activities sponsored by ANCHORAGE YOUTH UNITED. The Participant(s) and I understand that SEAT BELTS SHALL BE WORN AT ALL TIMES during transportation.
